Legislative proposals

Regulation on the European Health Data Space (EHDS)

- The Regulation aims to:
 - o to establish a single European area for sharing health data
 - Set the legal framework and support the construction of health data exchange infrastructure for primary use (use for healthcare delivery) as well as for secondary use (use for research, innovation, policy making, personalised care, etc.)
 - o improving individuals' access to their health data, including strengthening control over its use
- CZ PRES has prepared a compromise text of Chapters II and III
- Presidency objective: to present a progress report to the EPSCO Council



Legislative proposals

Draft Blood, Tissues and Cells (BTC) Regulation

- The Regulation aims to:
 - to cover the whole BTC area, which has been newly expanded to include other parts such as breast milk or medically assisted reproduction
 - o strengthen security for BTC donors and recipients
 - \circ to strengthen the resilience of the sector on the basis of more room for innovation
- CZ PRES discussed a list of 70 definitions, to which it prepared a compromise proposal
- Presidency objective: to present a progress report to the EPSCO Council



Legislative proposals

Revision of the Directive on the protection of workers from the risks related to exposure to asbestos at work

- The revision of the Directive aims to:
 - o reduce the asbestos exposure limit values by a factor of ten, i.e. to 0.01 fibres per cm³
 - ensure the availability of up-to-date and scientifically proven methods for measuring airborne fibre concentrations
 - to clarify the definition of asbestos as a fibrous silicate classified as a carcinogen in order to avoid confusion and divergent interpretations of the Directive and the Regulation on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures (1272/2008)
- Presidency objective: adoption of a general approach at the EPSCO Council (employment and social policy part)



Non-legislative proposals and priorities

Revision of the Council Recommendation on cancer screening

- The revision of the recommendations aims to:
 - o adjusting the age categories of the three existing screening programmes (breast, cervical and colon cancer screening)
 - o addition of three new screening programmes (prostate, lung and stomach cancer screening)
 - o reflection of the latest scientific findings and methods of investigation
- Presidency objective: approval by the EPSCO Council





Non-legislative proposals and priorities

Strengthening the EU's role in international health

- During the CZ PRES, negotiations began on a new international instrument for pandemic prevention and response, the so-called Pandemic Convention, as well as on amendments to the International Health Regulations (2005)
- CZ PRES advocates the establishment of an Informal Cooperation Mechanism (ICM) between groups of health diplomats based at the WHO in Geneva and at the EU in Brussels and the headquarters of the Member States, as well as with the EU institutions, in order to effectively exchange information in real time
- Presidency goal: CZ PRES and the EC will inform the EPSCO Council meeting on 9 December about the negotiations in the context of the Pandemic Convention and the amendments to the International Health Regulations (2005). Alternatively, the EC will provide information on the revision of the EU Global of Council Conclusions to be negotiated by SE PRES

Council conclusions on vaccination

- CZ PRES drafted the Council conclusions on vaccination as the most effective tool for prevention
- The Council conclusions stress the importance of communication and the need to use the lessons learned from the covid-19 pandemic
- Presidency objective: adoption by the EPSCO Council





Negotiations at ministerial level

Informal meeting of Ministers for Health

- Held on 6 7 September in Prague
- Topics:
 - Helping the health system in Ukraine
 - Debate on the future of vaccination
 - Debate on oncology and the way forward for the European Cancer Plan •
 - Negotiations with manufacturers of vaccines against covid-19 and monkeypox (organised by the EC on the sidelines of the informal ministerial meeting)
